
## High Street Out 10<sup>th</sup> May – 5<sup>th</sup> June2023

The Sam 2 monitor was positioned on lamp post 4, situated at the entrance to the Angel Public House, High Street, Loddon on the 10<sup>th</sup> of May 2023. It was positioned facing towards Church Plain and it commenced recording vehicle speeds at 1.45pm that day. It was removed from this position at 2.20pm on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> of June 2023. When the data was looked at it was found that the monitor had stopped recording at 6.10am on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June. The reason for this appears to be that the battery power had dropped below the working limit.

During the time that the monitor was working it recorded 54,168 vehicles and the maximum speed of 85% of these vehicles (46,050) was 23.1mph.



The speeds recorded were as follows;

- 05 10mph 1,199
- 10 15mph 8,710
- 15 20mph 24,527
- 20 25mph 15,400
- 25 30mph 2,103
- 30 35mph 187
- 35 40mph 31
- 40 45 mph 8
- 45 50mph 3

The daily totals were as follows;

15<sup>th</sup> – 21 May (2,270 / 2,384 / 2,450 / 2,422 / 2,609 / 2,050 / 1,492)

29<sup>th</sup> May – 04 June ( 1,802 / 2,456 / 1,995 / 2,022 / 1,958 / 1,797 / 1,224)

05<sup>th</sup> June (24)

Looking at the 19<sup>th</sup> May the hourly numbers from midnight to midnight were as follows;

(4 / 2 / 1 / 3 / 1 / 3 / 50 / 93 / 263 / 123 / 152 / 160 / 193 / 233 / 261 / 252 / 170 / 133 / 73 / 55 / 52 / 26).

The monitor was then positioned on the lamp post on Beccles Road beside the church path. It is positioned to record the speed of vehicles travelling towards the High Street.
