
Sam 2 High Bungay Road Incoming.

February – March 2024.

The Sam 2 monitor was positioned on lamp post 9 High Bungay Road on Saturday 10th February. It was positioned to record the speed of vehicles travelling along High Bungay Road towards High Street. I began recording at 3.00pm that day and the data was downloaded at 9.00am on Wednesday 6th March, a total of 26 days. During that time it recorded the speed of 15,126 vehicles. The maximum speed of 85% of those vehicles (12,857) was 28.4mph. The maximum speed recorded was 50mph.


It is noticeable that the volume of traffic reduces dramatically during the school holidays.

The maximum speed of vehicles recorded each hour over the same two days were as follows;

The Sam 2 monitor has now been positioned on the lamp post situated at the junction of George Lane and Kittens Lane. It is positioned in a manner that it will record the speed of vehicles travelling along George Lane from the A146.
