

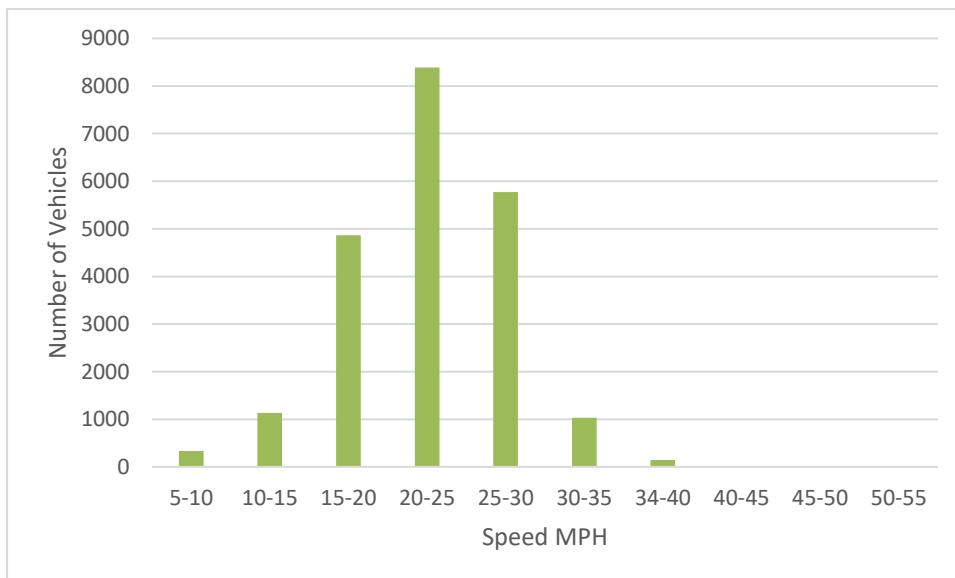
Sam 2 High Bungay Road In 4

1pm Monday 16/01/23 – 1pm Sunday 12/02/23.

The Sam 2 monitor was positioned on Lamp post 9, near 50 High Bungay Road, at 1pm on Monday 16th January 2023. It was positioned facing towards the A146 in order to monitor vehicles travelling along High Bungay Road towards the High Street. The data recorded was downloaded at 1pm on Sunday 12th February 2023.

During the time it was in position it recorded a total of 21,684 vehicles. This road has a 30mph speed restriction in place. 85% of vehicles (18,431) were recorded as travelling at a maximum speed of 28.2mph. However one vehicle did travel at 65mph and this was recorded at 6.55pm on Friday 20/01/23.

The speed of vehicles recorded were as follows;



05 – 10mph 330

10 – 15mph 1,135

15 – 20mph 4,864

20 – 25mph 8,388

25 – 30mph 5,773

30 – 35mph 1,028

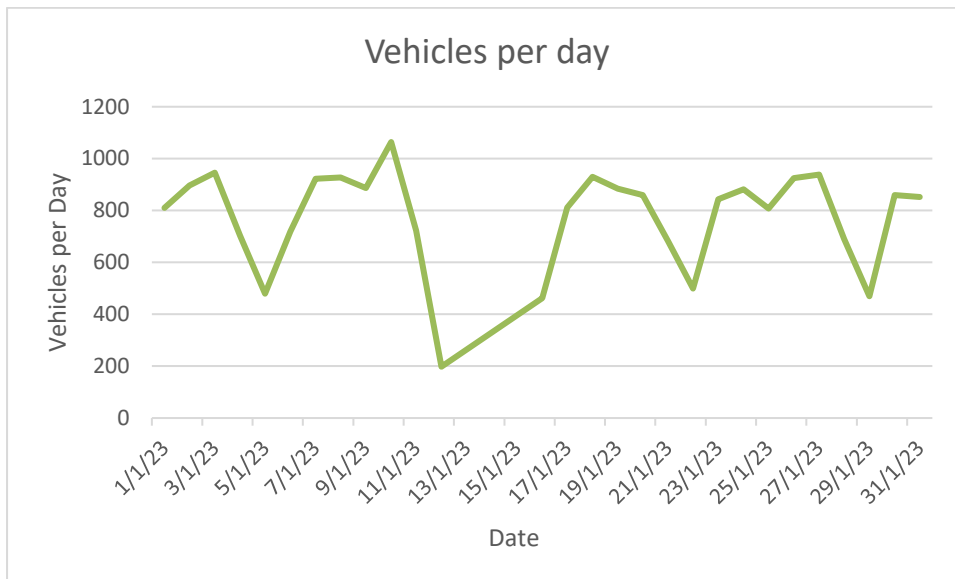
35 – 40mph 144

40 – 45mph 17

45 – 50mph 4

60 – 65mph 1

The daily number of vehicles recorded were as follows;



16th – 22nd (462/812/930/884/860/682/499)

23rd – 29th (844/882/808/925/939/690/469)

30th – 05th (860/852/810/897/946/703/480)

06th – 12th (719/922/927/887/1,064/723/198)

The hourly figures (starting at 0.00 – 1.00am) for Friday 20th January and Friday 10th February were as follows;

20th Jan. (1/1/0/1/0/2/11/56/108/57/44/63/33/60/47/84/67/64/60/26/38/17/19/1)

10th Feb (2/0/3/0/0/1/18/54/113/66/62/60/63/72/87/100/86/78/84/48/24/22/17/4).

It is noticeable that between 8am and 9am on each day there is the highest numbers recorded 108 and 113 respectively. Also during 3pm and 4pm again the volume increases, 84 and 100 respectively.

During those hours the maximum speed recorded was 20th Jan 40mph and 35mph and on the 10th Feb 40mph on both occasions.
