
Sam 2 George Lane by Kittens Lane

February – March 2023.

The Sam 2 monitor was moved to lamp post 14, situated at the junction of George Lane and Kittens Lane, on Saturday 25th February 2023 after being moved from High Bungay Road where it is believed it had been struck by a vehicle. The monitor was positioned in a way that it could record the speed of vehicles travelling along George Lane towards the A146. The data on the monitor was downloaded at 2pm on Wednesday 22nd of March.

On looking at the data recorded it was found that the monitor had stopped recording vehicles between 7.00 and 8.00am on the 22nd of March. This is probably due to the battery having not been replaced when it was moved from High Bungay Road. The battery had not been replaced at this time as it had only been in situ for a few days before needing to be moved. As a result I have looked at the data and this report now covers up to midnight on Tuesday 21st March. All figures have been adjusted accordingly.

The total number of vehicles recorded up to midnight 24/3/23 was 24,016. The maximum speed of 85% of these vehicles (20,413) was 29.4mph.



The speeds recorded were as follows;

05 - 10mph 177

10 – 15mph 1,725

15 - 20mph 3,950

20 - 25mph 7,616

25 - 30mph 7,865

30 - 35mph 2,173

35 - 40mph 423

40 - 45mph 74

45 – 50mph 5



The total number of vehicles recorded each day were as follows;

25th – 26th Feb (697 / 662)

27th Feb – 05th Mar (1,037 / 1,074 / 1,060 / 1,136 / 1,145 / 831 / 582)

 $06^{th} - 12^{th} Mar (1,035 / 1,102 / 1,113 / 1,025 / 977 / 786 / 580)$

 $13^{th} - 19^{th} Mar (1,054 / 1,070 / 1,088 / 1,090 / 1,169 / 853 / 780)$

20th - 21st Mar (1,045 / 1,025)

The monitor is still on the same lamp post but has been turned so that it can monitor the traffic travelling along George Lane from the A146 towards Bridge Street.
